

## **RESEARCH POSITIONS IN MACROECONOMICS, INTERNATIONAL ECONOMICS AND RELATED FIELDS**

The Center for Research in International Economics (CREi) invites applications for research positions at both senior and junior levels. Fields of interest include:

CREi is a research institute sponsored by the Government of Catalonia and Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF), and an academic unit of the Barcelona Graduate School of Economics (Barcelona GSE). It is located within the UPF campus in Barcelona.

Junior researchers are offered tenure-track positions subject to an evaluation after six years. Terms of appointment are flexible and competitive. CREi researchers have no teaching obligations but are encouraged to participate in UPF and Barcelona GSE academic programs. English is the working language at CREi.

Applicants must hold (or obtain by the end of 2020) a PhD in Economics. Applications, including a CV, a recent research paper and three reference letters, should be submitted through <https://econjobmarket.org> by November 22, 2019. Selected candidates will be interviewed at the EEA European Job Market to be held in Rotterdam (Netherlands) on December 18-19, 2019. Applicants should indicate whether they will be attending the meeting.

CREi has received the European Commission's 'HR Excellence in Research' award, recognizing its commitment to providing favorable working conditions and career development for researchers. Seeking to promote a balanced gender representation among its staff, CREi encourages women to apply.
