This workshop, jointly organized by the Centre de Recerca en Economia Internacional (CREI) and the Barcelona GSE, aims to discuss recent theoretical and empirical advances in the study of international capital flows. We welcome papers on International Economics, Macroeconomics and Finance related to the following topics:

- Financial crises and capital flows
- Sovereign debt crises
- Capital flows, risk taking and financial fragility
- Monetary policy and capital flows
- Effects of capital controls
- Credit markets and economic activity in the open economy
- Interaction of public and private capital flows

The workshop will take place on **June 13-14, 2016** in Barcelona. The deadline for submissions is **February 29, 2016**. To submit a paper, please use this link <https://app-summerforum.barcelonagse.eu>. Submissions should include either a full paper or an extended abstract with the main results. Authors chosen to present papers will be notified by mid March 2016. A preliminary program will be announced by early April 2016. Travel and accommodation expenses will be covered for speakers and discussants according to specified guidelines.

The workshop is part of the fourth Barcelona GSE Summer Forum. The Summer Forum is a series of independent workshops and policy events that cover the main fields of Economics. The fourth Summer Forum will take place from June 6 to 21, 2016.
