



INTERNATIONAL CAPITAL FLOWS Barcelona GSE Summer Forum 2017 CALL FOR PAPERS

This workshop, jointly organized by the Centre de Recerca en Economia Internacional (CREI), the Barcelona GSE, and the European Stability Mechanism, aims to discuss recent theoretical and empirical advances in the study of international capital flows. We welcome papers on International Economics, Macroeconomics and Finance related to the following topics:

- Financial crises and capital flows
- Sovereign debt crises
- Interaction of public and private capital flows
- Capital flows, risk taking and financial fragility Effects of capital controls
- Credit markets and economic activity in the open economy
- Monetary policy and capital flows

The workshop will take place on **June 8-9, 2017** in Barcelona. The deadline for submissions is **February 28, 2017**. To submit a paper, please use this link <https://app-summerforum.barcelonagse.eu>. Submissions should include either a full paper or an extended abstract with the main results. Authors chosen to present papers will be notified by mid March 2017. A preliminary program will be announced by early April 2017. Travel and accommodation expenses will be covered for speakers and discussants according to specified guidelines.

The workshop is part of the Fifth Barcelona GSE Summer Forum. The Summer Forum is a series of independent workshops and policy events that cover the main fields of Economics. The Fifth Summer Forum will take place from May 31 to June 17, 2017.
